Dear Danette Guy,

I am writing on behalf of 350PDX, a grassroots organization with 10,000 supporters in the Pacific Northwest in urging you to please Support the “no action” alternative of the DEIS, urge the Corps to deny the project’s Clean Water Act Section 404 and Rivers and Harbors Act Section 10 permits. For similar reasons, we urge Ecology to deny Millennium’s Clean Water Action Section 401 water quality certification. Millennium has failed to demonstrate that it can prevent coal and coal dust from entering the Columbia River, both at the project site and en route to the terminal. The project also flies in the face of our region’s commitment to combat the devastating impacts of climate change. Millennium’s ambitions to rebrand the Pacific Northwest the coal export capital of the U.S. is in direct conflict with the public interest in thriving local economies, clean water, clean energy, and healthy communities.
