HOPE is a SW Portland eco-faith group committed to taking action for climate, social and economic justice. We are writing to support the “no action” alternative of the DEIS for the Millennium Bulk Terminals in Longview WA and urge you to deny Millennium’s Clean Water Act Section 404 and Rivers Harbors Act Section 10. Millennium has failed to demonstrate that it can prevent coal and coal dust from entering the Columbia River both at the project site and en route to the terminal. The scope of the DEIS is insufficient. It does not take into account coal export’s impact on rail communities including Olympia and the National Scenic Area (NSA). It focuses on a very small are of potential impact for its analysis of the adverse effects of the additional 5,840 trains that would run as a result of the project.
