RE: Millennium Bulk Terminals Longview, LLC; NWS-2010-1225

Please deny Clean Water Act permits for the Millennium coal export proposal in Longview, Washington. Millennium's reckless project would cause unacceptable harm to water quality, aquatic life, fishing, and other important uses of the Columbia River.

Shipping 44 million tons of coal per day through our communities, and on our waterways, would harm public health and safety. And Millennium's climate-polluting coal directly threatens the State of Washington's efforts to fight climate change.

The Department of Ecology must deny Water Quality Certification because the project would harm protected uses of the Columbia, including clean water for salmon, fishing, and recreation.

The Army Corps must deny the project's dredging and dock construction permits because Millennium's dirty and dangerous proposal is not in the public interest.

Please prevent coal export from polluting our river, our towns, and our climate.
