

Millenium Bulk Comments

Dear U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Washington Department of Ecology, and Cowlitz County,

I'm writing to urge you to choose the "No Action" alternative for Millennium Bulk Terminals' proposed coal-export facility in Longview, Wash. The proposal threatens community health and safety, air and water quality, and endangered species. I urge your agencies to protect public health and endangered species and say no to coal exports in Longview.

From mines in Montana, across tracks in Idaho, onto barges in Washington, and then through smoke stacks in Asia, coal poses an unacceptable threat to our health and climate. Mining pollution, coal dust, accidental spills, increased diesel exhaust and greenhouse gas emissions would all have significant impacts.

The only reasonable action is to select the No Action Alternative and disallow this coal-export terminal from being built.
