

Re: Millennium Bulk Terminal EIS,

I'm writing to urge you to take climate change into account in all coal export terminal permitting decisions, and to reject the permits for Millennium Bulk Terminals' proposed coal-export terminal in Washington.

Coal companies want to mine taxpayer-owned coal in Montana and Wyoming, ship it to the West Coast by rail, then export it to Asia.

It's a badly flawed plan. The terminal would crowd out investments in clean energy, encourage investments in dirty coal plants in Asia and cause a spike in global-warming emissions by making taxpayer subsidized American coal available to growing Asian economies.

Americans are campaigning successfully to shut down dirty coal plants in the U.S. and we don't want our efforts undermined by companies shipping taxpayer-owned, carbon-intensive coal to be burned in Asia instead. You must take the catastrophic climate impacts of increased coal exports into account and reject the terminal's permits.

Please let me know how you intend to address this issue.
