RE: Comments on Millennium Bulk Terminals Proposal

To: U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Washington Department of Ecology, and Cowlitz County Commission

In your consideration of impacts of the construction of a coal export terminal at Longview, Washington, I urge you to thoroughly review the negative effects it will have on the Lower Columbia River region.

While a facility to export coal would offer modest long-time regional employment, it would have highly detrimental implications for a large portion of the population. Coal trains would cause significant automobile congestion at street crossings and noise pollution at potentially any time of day or night. The added pollution to air and water will have negative impacts on human health as well as harming the environment for fish and other ecosystems.

Local business will be impacted negatively by traffic congestion that will curtail the movement of goods and services throughout the region. Added cost from these impacts will significantly harm some segments of the economy.

I trust you will thoroughly examine these issues relative to the Environmental Impact Statement.
