I am opposed to the construction of a coal export terminal at Longview, WA which would bring coal to Cowlitz County and export it on ships down the Columbia River.


This facility would have very negative impacts on the community due to the increased rail traffic that will not only bring noise and exhaust pollution, but will create major traffic problems unless there are major changes to railroad crossings, especially on Oregon Way.

The coal dust potential for the city of Longview is a very big problem. Winds coming up the Columbia River will almost certainly disperse coal dust on a significant part of the city from both the train cars and the huge coal piles awaiting export vessels.

These negative impacts not only affect the local citizens directly, but they have very detrimental consequences for other businesses in Longview who must recruit workers from out of the area. Currently we have difficulty bringing trained professionals to our city and with the additional pollution and congestion from a coal export terminal, this problem will be greatly increased.

In your review of the Environmental Impact, please look carefully at these concerns.
