

RE: The Impact of the proposed Millennium Coal Terminal on the Columbia River at the former Reynold's Metal site (Alcoa)

Dear State and Federal Agencies,

Following are my concerns and the areas I believe need full evaluation and assessment:

- **Health and environmental impact of "surfactants" which will be sprayed on piles of coal.**
- **Impact on air quality and health as a result of exhaust from additional diesel train traffic**
- **Establish noise levels and impact on the community from added train traffic and activities at the site.**
- **Health impact of coal dust to humans as well as natural environment, wildlife and river**
- **Establish the potential for congestion as it effects commuters and especially emergency vehicles traveling from Oregon side of river to healthcare services in Longview**

- **Hold Alcoa accountable for cleaning up the site first. Do not tie it to Millenium successfully locating the coal terminal here. Community is held hostage – if one tied to the other. CLEAN UP THE SITE FIRST.**

I do not support a coal terminal in my community due to what I perceive as the negative impact to air quality, concerns about "surfactants", increased noise level, and the risk of traffic tie ups that will negatively impact commuters and especially emergency transportation.
