Dear U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, WA Department of Ecology, and Cowlitz County Commission,

I strongly oppose the construction of a coal export terminal at Longview, WA, which would transport coal on trains and ships throughout the Northwest.

This proposal would negatively affect my community by polluting our ground and water. The current site for the Millennium coal terminal is already on the federal clean up list. This site should be cleaned up before any company can use it for anything else. I want it to be cleaned up as best as it can be to meet the most stringent guidelines. I am worried this won't happen. I am also concerned that the coal terminal will contaminate this site more and the surrounding area. Will the coal terminal pollute the ground too? Will our water quality be affected? Already the salmon runs have diminished. Could this coal terminal pollute the river more and further diminish the amount of salmon? Will this have a negative impact on the salmon, other fish, and water creatures that live and migrate in the river? Will the fish caught in the surrounding rivers be safe to eat? Could this affect our drinking water that is pumped from a site nearby? I have so many concerns and questions. Will you please consider these?
