The movement of coal & the related dust is not a natural activity related to coal. Therefore, it is incumbent on the reviewing agency to consider the effects of this transport during EIS review. For example, when an application is submitted for the excavation of coal, the immediate impacts on the environment are taken into consideration for the EIS. It has been demonstrated that the coal itself, and not just its transport, has an effect on the environment.
