

Dear U.S. Army Corps of Engineers,

On November 1, 2013, President Obama issued Executive Order -- Preparing the United States for the Impacts of Climate Change.

Section 3 of the Executive Order states: "*...agencies shall, where possible, focus on program and policy adjustments that promote the dual goals of greater climate resilience and carbon sequestration, or other reductions to the sources of climate change.*"

(Note: The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is one of the agencies specified in section 3 of the Executive Order.)

It seems to me that a relevant policy adjustment to promote "*reductions to the sources of climate change*" would be to consider the effect of the burning of coal by allowing coal exports through a yet to be built coal terminal.

I strongly oppose the construction of a coal export terminal at Longview, WA which would allow the export of coal to foreign markets. It makes no sense to allow the construction of coal export terminals at a time when the world needs to take bold steps to dramatically reduce our carbon dioxide emissions!

I strongly urge you to consider this impact in the scope of the Environmental Impact Statement.
