



The Millennium coal export terminal would make Washington the coal export capital of the United States, bringing 44 million tons of dirty coal through our communities every year. The federal government's Draft Environmental Impact Study is your opportunity to stand up dirty coal.

**Coal is a health risk** to Longview and communities throughout the Pacific Northwest, worsening climate change and contributing to increased rates of asthma and heart disease.

**The coal industry is a sinking ship.** Demand in Asia is drying up as communities continue to stand up to coal companies and demand healthy air and clean jobs. Longview shouldn't tie its economy to a dying industry.

**Millennium can't be trusted.** In 2011, Millennium was caught lying about their coal export



proposal, planning a terminal 10 times larger than they reported to officials and the public.

Last spring the Department of Ecology and Cowlitz County received over 260,000 comments on their review of Millennium. U.S. Fish and Wildlife, U.S. EPA, Washington Department of Health, the Columbia River Inter-Tribal Fish Commission, and the Cowlitz Tribe—just to name a few—joined you raising concerns or outright objecting to coal export. Attend a hearing and submit a comment to ensure the Army Corps can't overlook the opposition to coal exports!




